CAMPING RULES & REGULATIONS

- The only area that is open free camping is the far southwest end of the entire grounds. Those areas are on a roads and boundaries will be marked with paint. Please stay within the confines of the area near your unit. Unreserved campers MUST all park in an east-west direction, per fire marshall and the LaCrosse County Health Department Camping Permit.
- THOURS: Camparound quiet hours will be enforced 1:00 am to 6:00 a.m., as a courtesy to everyone. Please limit
- wristband because of violator's conduct.
- area is reserved for CAR PARKING. Both sides of the lot east and west are reserved camping. Also Camping is not permitted in
- ASSING: Please stay out of the buildings, barns, etc. Violators will be considered Trespassers and are subject to law
- ITS: Pets are allowed but must be on a leash at all times (State Health Dept, Regulations). Pets may not be left unattended. Clean up pet waste. Pets are NOT allowed in the grandstands or the pit areas.

- Absolutely No Bonfires. Do not burn ties, furniture, pallets, or anything with nails. Use Supplied (limited supply) free Naturally Organic Grown Firewood. Please do not destroy buildings, fences, etc., (Please be respectful to others enjoying the event, and take only what you will need from the FREE wood for the weekend.)

 HOT COALS: Please DO NOT Put them in trash barrels or dumpsters.


 GARBAGE: Please throw bagged refuse into dumpsters.

 GLASS CONTAINERS: Please dispose of in a trash barrel for everyone's safety.

- GOLF CARTS & ATVS: Permits are REQUIRED for golf carts & ATVS, etc. No use after 11pm. Must have lights in use between 6-11pm. MUST HAVE PERMIT. Get permit application at oktoberfestraceweekend.com, at Speedway office or registration desk.
