OKTOBERFEST RACE WEEKEND CAMPING GENERAL RULES

REFUSE: Please bag your trash & place in dumpsters located throughout camping areas.

HAULERS: Park in the Hauler Parking area to the East of Pischke Motors (car dealership).

CO: Carbon monoxide is a colorless, odorless deadly gas. Please do not use portable heaters or lanterns while sleeping in tents, campers, or vehicles. Also do not use a charcoal grill or propane indoors unless specified for indoor use. RVs with exhaust tubes – please run it away from nearby campers.

ELECTRIC: There is a very limited number of electrical hook-ups. They are first come, first served. Do not open or tamper with the electrical panels, or do any electrical work to any Fairgrounds property. YOU WILL BE SUBJECT TO REMOVAL FROM GROUNDS IMMEDIATELY and you will also Lose renewal privileges. Respect the property of others, and do not remove other campers' cords in occupied outlets. This too, will cause you to lose your camping spot.

GENERATORS: Are Permitted, and we recommend you chain it to your unit. If it does not have a "quiet" mode, it must be turned off at 1am.

BOUNDARIES: PLEASE STAY WITHIN THE CONFINES OF THE AREA MEASURED OR "DESIGNATED" as your campsite. Campers must be parked in an orderly direction to comply with health dept. regulations and emergency services.

FIRE LANES: DO NOT PARK IN THE CAMPGROUND ROADS ("fire lanes"). Please be considerate of others that need to move through campgrounds. Violators will be towed with one of the four wreckers we have on the grounds. We are not responsible for any damages.

ATV, GOLF CART, UTV, ETC.: If you choose to operate one of these on the grounds, YOU MUST have a permit. The permit must be visible. Proof of insurance is required to obtain a permit. NO MOTORIZED 2-WHEEL UNITS ALLOWED ON GROUNDS. PERMIT registration forms are available at OktoberfestRaceWeekend.com/camper-village/. You may print and mail that in with payment – please do as soon as possible. **A NON-REGISTERED GOLF CART /ATV / UTV / ETC. VEHICLE FOUND IN OPERATION - at any time - WILL IMMEDIATELY TERMINATE YOUR RESERVED CAMPSITES AND FURTHER ACTION MAY TAKE PLACE AS DEEMED NECESSARY BY TRACK OFFICIALS.**

CAMPER WASTEWATER: Camper septic tanks or "grey water" may not be emptied on Fairgrounds Property. Any Violators will be dealt with through law enforcement, and they will permanently lose any camping reservation opportunities.

HOT COALS: Please DO NOT dump any hot coals or ashes in trash cans or dumpsters.

FIRE RINGS: Are provided for your campfire. Firewood is provided for your campfire. Please do not take any more firewood than you need for your campfire during the event. Be respectful that other campers would like to use firewood too – don't hoard it. NO BONFIRES or EXCESSIVE sized fires. Keep fire contained to the size of the fire rings.

QUIET HOURS: Have fun, but please be considerate to those camping or sleeping around you.

QUIET HOURS FROM 1 A.M. UNTIL 6:00 A.M. WILL BE ENFORCED. Please turn off your generators and any stereos, etc. during this time. If security or speedway staff determines that your behavior is inappropriate, we will not hesitate to remove you from the property, and you will forfeit your camping spot.

FIREWORKS: Fireworks are not permitted on any fairgrounds or speedway property at any time.

RESERVED / UNRESERVED AREAS: We reserve the right to accommodate the increasing demand and limited supply of camping spaces by adding reserved spots and reducing the availability of unreserved areas as deemed necessary.

RESPONSIBILITY: You are responsible for anyone associated with your reserved camping spot. You are responsible for anyone using YOUR Registered CART / ATV / UTV / ETC Permit. Please help us keep respectful behavior on the grounds in accordance with the spirit of the event. Let's all have fun, but know when to draw the line.

REMOVAL: All camping units must be removed by 11 A.M. on Tuesday Oct. 10.

OUR CAMPING ATTENDANTS WILL DO THEIR BEST TO FIND YOU A PLACE TO PARK ON-SITE IF YOU DO NOT HAVE A RESERVED SPACE.
