**LENGTH OF TRACK:** Large Track - 5/8 mile • Small Track - 1/4

**SURFACE:** 5/8 Mile - Six inch highway grade asphalt over five inch base of ground asphalt from original pavement. First paved July 1970, repayed in 1994. Quarter mile - Six inch asphalt over three inch base, paved in 1988, repaved in 2022.

WIDTH OF TRACKS: All straights 50 foot wide; half mile turns 60 foot wide; guarter mile turns 50 (2 & 3) and 75 foot (1 & 4) wide. **RETAINING WALL:** Steel Reinforced concrete wall, 3.5 feet

high, 90 degrees to racing surface on half mile. Quarter mile has movable, steel reinforced cement highway barriers secured with steel cable.

**TOTAL TRACK ACREAGE: 35 Acres** 

TYPES OF RACING: NASCAR Weekly Series Late Models, Sportsmen, Hornets, Mini-Vans, Street Stocks, High School, 6-Shooters.

**RACING SCHEDULE:** Events nearly every Saturday night, mid-May through early-September, plus specials throughout the season and the Annual Oktoberfest Race Weekend in early October.

**SAFETY VEHICLES:** Five Fire/Safety Trucks, one ambulance, three recovery tow vehicles, two water trucks, 2 garbage trucks, plus a rolling dumpster, a GMC Sonoma & an S-10.

WHEN OPENED: Began operation as dirt track in 1957. First operated as an asphalt track in July 1970.
